ART CONTEST

Earth Day celebrates our planet's wonders. Show what you see when you think of clean air, water, and land. Show your vision of how we can honor, celebrate and protect our environment.

Who: Students in third through fifth grades at Jesse Bobo, Mary H. Wright, E. P. Todd, and Arcadia Elementary Schools can enter their artwork by March 16, 2018.

What: Will submit a two dimensional work on an 11x14 or 8.5 x 11 inch sheet of paper.

- ❖ Acceptable media: acrylics, oils, water colors, pastels, chalk, charcoal, pencils, ink, crayon, or collages. Chalk, pastels, and charcoal must be affixed.
- ❖ All artwork must be the student's original composition. Only the student submitting the material can perform work on the entry. No copies, by hand, electronic, or mechanical device, or any previously published piece of art, or copyright-protected material will be allowed.
- ❖ Please legibly print your name, address, grade, school, and art teacher's name on the back. The artist may indicate which direction they would like their art to be displayed by drawing an arrow indicating "UP" on the back.

When: Artwork must be started after January 1, 2018 and completed by March 16, 2018.

All students should review the rules carefully. Student questions should be directed to the school's art teacher.

The Earth Day Festival will arrange pick up of art finalist entries from schools and will display them at the festival. Each participating school may submit 8 entries. Each of those submitted entries will be awarded a certificate at our festival Awards Ceremony. The first place entry from each school will be professionally framed and given to the school at the conclusion of the Spartanburg Earth Day Festival. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners from each school will also receive a collection of art supplies.
