- 10 x 10 outdoor spaces are available for \$50. Artists must provide 10 x 10 canopy, 8' table, and needed chairs for these spaces.
- Indoor spaces are available for \$60. Spaces are 10' x 5' and will accommodate an 8' table. Artists will supply their own tables and chairs. 12 of our spaces offer wall space. Bulletin boards will be available for 6 of those spaces. Spaces are limited and will be assigned on a first registered, first reserved status.
- All funds generated by the festival underwrite festival expenses. Any excess funds seed the next year's festival.
- Our professional marketer and increased community outreach allow us to expect over 1000 people at this year's festival.
